

Step 1: Choose device (minimum spec recommended 32gb)

Step 2: Choose optional warranty and/or Apple Care

Step 3: Enter personal details

Step 4: Select payment option (Visa, BPAY, 12mth Interest Free)

What happens when my iPad is **enrolled into St Luke's Device** Enrolment Program?

NEW DEVICE:

- If you have purchased a brand new device, then before opening and setting up your iPad, simply bring it to school on the nominated date. We will update and enroll.
- Once it is enrolled, when you switch it on, you can use as you please.

EXISTING DEVICE:

- You will need to bring your device to school on a nominated date.
- Existing photos and data is wiped and then enrolled into St Luke's

How do I enrol my iPad if I am purchasing it brand new?

Before you hand the shiny new device over to your children:

1. Once you receive the device – bring it to school on one of the nominated dates
 2. We will enroll the device and upgrade it to iOS 11
 3. You are free to use the device as you please
- (If you don't bring it to school, on the first day of school 2018, it will be wiped)



How does ZuluDesk Management System work?

Teacher App – available on iPad or web browser

Parent App – available on your phone or via a web browser

What dates can I bring in my iPad to enrol in Term 4?

The following are dates to bring in your existing iPad for enrolment:

Term 4, 2017:

Week 3 - Thursday 26th October 8:30am

Week 5 - Thursday 9th November 8:30am

Week 7 - Thursday 23rd November 8:30am

Please bring your iPad to the front office, with your name clearly labelled on the device. It will be completed during the day and available for pickup at the end of the day.

QUESTIONS

Currently how long do the year 4 use the current computers per day/week?

- This varies day-to-day, week-to-week depending on the task. However, current data suggests no more than an hour a day.

In your discussion with your staff do they feel there will be an increase in 'screen' time for students with this being implemented?

- This will depend on the type of work being completed. The focus is on enhancing the teaching and learning with digital content creation and collaboration. If the teachers feel the use of the device will assist children in their learning then they will have the option to use it. Eg. Manipulatives in maths.

What are the current studies regarding amount of 'screen time' per day children of this age should be exposed to?

Will the year 4 students all be given ergonomic, supportive chairs with appropriate table heights with the implementation of collaborative learning spaces?

- Even with the move to collaborative learning spaces, there will still be a focus on ergonomically, supportive chairs in each Year 4 classroom. Eg. Year 3 – minimum 20 chairs/class.
